The two years must be in the same language.Earn a 'C' grade or better from CHINESE 120, 121; JAPANESE 120, 121; SPANISH 120, 121, 220, 221, 230, 231 or one semester of college work in a language other than English equivalent to two years of high school work.Satisfactory completion with grades equivalent to " C " $(2.0)$ or better in the native language, with two years of formal schooling at the sixth grade level or higher in an institution where the language of instruction is NOT English (confirmed by documentation).Satisfactory score on the SAT II: Subject test in languages other than English. Check with your counselor for required scores.Satisfactory score of 3 or higher on the College Board Advanced Placement (AP) Exams in a languages other than English.
$\square$ Satisfactory score of 5 or higher on the International Baccalaureate (IB) Higher Level Examinations in languages other than English.
