## Graduation Checklist

1. Completed OR in last semester of completing 60 Degree Applicable Units
2. Completed minimum of $\mathbf{1 2}$ Degree Applicable Units at Contra Costa College
3. Completed all requirements in Major with a ' $\mathbf{C}$ ' grade or higher.
4. Have Official Transcripts from other institutions attended on file with Admissions and Records Office.
5. Have AP/CLEP/IB documents on file with Admissions and Records Office.
6. Recently met with a Counselor to review completion of degree requirements.
7. Petition for Associate Degree(s) by going to m.4cd.edu by the following deadlines:

- March 1: Graduating Spring (May)
- July 1: Graduating Summer (July)
- October 15: Graduating Fall (December)


## Graduating with Honors:

- Honors Graduate: Earning a cumulative GPA between 3.25 and 3.74 in all Degree Applicable Units.
- President's Scholar: Earning a cumulative GPA of 3.75 or higher in all Degree Applicable Units.
- For pending petitions for degree or certificate, honors is determined by using the cumulative GPA from the previous term of enrollment and may change based on the cumulative GPA upon completion of all coursework and posting of the degree. Also, cumulative GPA may include coursework from other institutions.

Catalog Rights:
If continuous enrollment is maintained by enrolling in at least ONE course at CCC, DVC, or LMC in Academic Year (Fall, Spring, Summer), students are guaranteed rights to the catalog requirements in effect during their initial term of enrollment.
