April 1	Graduation Petition for summer 2025 graduates becomes available online (InSite>Graduation tile)
April 7	Group 1: Priority registration for EOPS/DSPS/Veterans/Foster Youth/CalWORKs/Homeless Youth/ Former Homeless Youth/Students w/dependent children under 18
April 8	Group 2: Note takers, early graduation, athletes
April 9	Group 3A: Continuing students with 45-75 units
April 10-11	Group 3B: Continuing with 0-44.99 units, Gateway, MCHS, and Dual Enrollment
April 14	Group 3C: Recent matriculated high school graduates
April 15	Group 3D: Continuing students with 75.01-99 units
April 17	Group 3E: New matriculated and returning students with less than 100 units
April 21	Group 4: Continuing and returning students over 100 degree applicable units or on 2nd semester probation/dismissal
May 5	Group 5: New non-matriculated
May 21	Group 6: Concurrent and transitional high school students
May 22	Group 7: All regular college students - open/walk-in registration
<b>May 27</b>	<b>First day of summer classes (nine-week session)</b>
May 26	Memorial Day - college closed
<b>June 9</b>	<b>First day of summer classes (six-week session)</b>
June 19	Juneteenth – college closed
July 4	Independence Day - college closed
July 15	Deadline to submit application for graduation for summer 2025 (InSite>Graduation tile)
<b>July 25</b>	<b>Last day of six and nine-week summer sessions (Grades are due 3 working days after last day of class. See Short Term Classes below.)</b>
August 1	Graduation Petition for fall 2025 graduates becomes available online (InSite>Graduation tile)
<b>August 24</b>	<b>Last day of summer semester (grades are due 3 working days after last day of class)</b>

- **Registration Dates**

- Continuing students can view their Summer and Fall registration date approximately mid-to-late-March by clicking on the Registration Dates in InSite.
- New and returning students can view their Summer and Fall registration dates within 24 hours of applying given the application is not flagged as potential SPAM.

- The Student Success Program includes placement, orientation, and completion of an educational plan. Enroll in Couns-108 or ESL-108.

- Students may register online until 11:59pm the day prior to the first class meeting.

- **Short-Term Classes**

- Dates to add, receive a refund or drop are calculated individually on the length of each course. To view course specific deadlines, log into InSite and select "My Schedule". You may also check with the instructor.
- Last day to request a Pass/No Pass is the Friday before the end of class.

- Grades for short-term classes are due 3 working days after the last class.
